2023 Mixed (Fours) National Championship

The USA Curling Mixed (Fours) National Championship is a regionally based, geographic championship aimed at determining the best mixed four person teams. Teams progress through a regional playdown process. The winning team of the Mixed (Fours) national Championship will advance to represent the United States at the Mixed World Championship.

- o Location:
 - Denver Curling Club
 - April 12-16, 2023
 - Eligibility:
 - Is a resident (no minimum residency required) of the United States as of registration deadline.
 - All players must be dues-paying members of a USA Curling member club within the registered region.
 - Teams must be comprised of two male and two female athletes.
 - Qualification:
 - Twelve (12) mixed curling teams will earn berths to the 2023 Mixed (Fours) National Championship through the following ways:
 - One team from each of the following regions: Alaska, Mid-America, Great Lakes, Midwest, Mountain Pacific, Dakota Territory, Pacific Northwest, Minnesota, Wisconsin, and GNCC OR AT-Large (dependent upon outcome of Members' Assembly vote on status of GNCC).
 - o The qualification process will be determined by each region.
 - The At-Large playdown will be hosted by USA Curling.
 - The region with the greatest number of entries for each field will receive an additional berth.
 - This will apply only if the Members' Assembly votes to remove the GNCC as a member region.
 - If the vote is not ratified, this berth will be allotted to GNCC.
 - O The host club will receive a berth for one team.
