USA Curling AAC Eligibility and Procedures

May 2024

All AAC Representatives must be from the 10-year athlete pool as defined in the USA Curling AAC Bylaws. This includes all athletes who have competed in the following events in the previous ten years:

- Olympics
- Paralympics
- World Championships
- USA Curling National Championships
- Pan Continental Championships
- World Qualification Events
- Olympic Qualification Events
- USA Olympic Team Trials
- USA Wheelchair Team Selection
- Grand Slam of Curling

The qualifying events are those in which the Olympic disciplines of Men's, Women's, and Mixed Doubles are competed, and Wheelchair competitions.

The AAC will open self-nominations for open positions at least two weeks ahead of voting. Athletes will submit self-nominations through an open web portal and indicate the position they are interested in and the method for which they qualify as a 10-year athlete.

Following the self-nomination period, the group of all 10-year athletes will be invited to cast votes to elect athletes to the open positions.

New AAC and committee members will be announced following voting.

The newly formed AAC will elect from within itself, the AAC Chair and Vice Chair, and any remaining board of director Directors as required to fulfill the 33% representation.
